- B. Rectory door and the heavy black railings are next.
- C. We have replaced the badly rusted wrought iron fencing around the little garden between the Hall and the Church, torn out the rotting benches on the street side of the Hall and replaced them with a new fence. Soon we will replace the fencing around the patio.
- D. Work has started to replace the damaged concrete stairs in front of the church, eliminating a potential safety hazard and improving the look of our patio area.
- E. We are erecting a small storage shed behind the Hall for the CYO to store their equipment.
