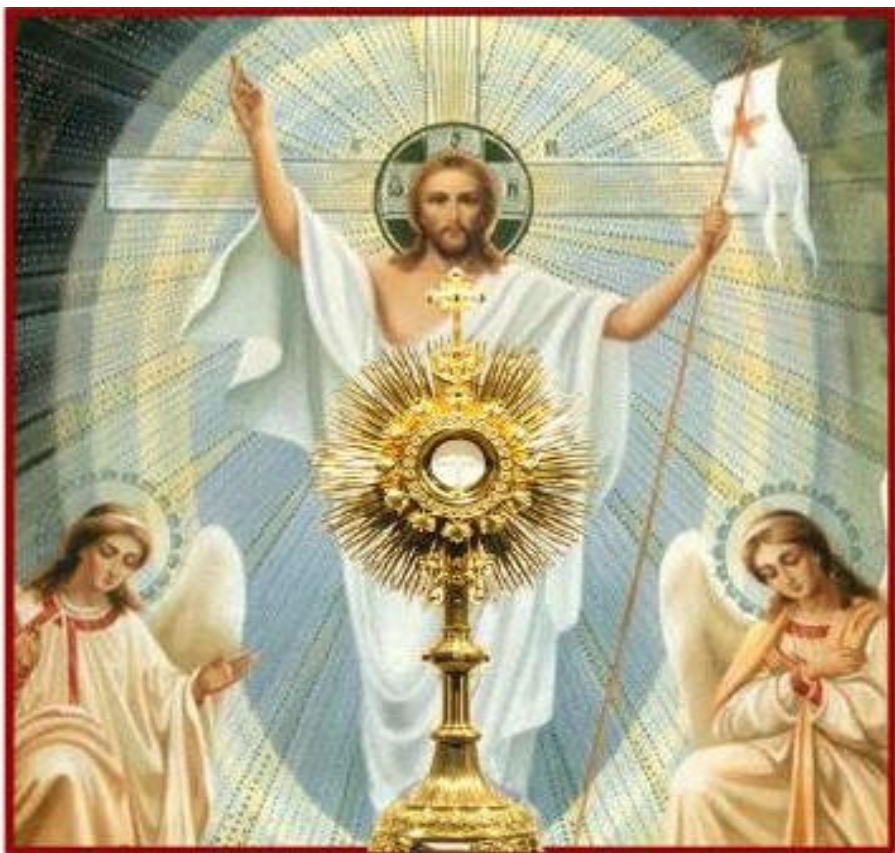

Vince Nims is a long-time friend of young people and youth ministry for 27 years. After graduating from Saint Mary's College of California with a BA in Religious Studies, he went right work at his first parish at St. Pius in Redwood City. Their small program grew into a large one that flourished with over 200 kids attending youth group.

After several years of parish work, his reputation as a trusted and dynamic leader led to his role as the Diocesan Director of Youth Adult Ministry for the Diocese of San Jose. While there, he founded a Catholic Summer Camp experience that has been operating for over 20 years.

Vince is also a popular Catholic musician. Early in his career, he began to receive requests to play guitar, sing songs, speak and lead retreats. His work and ministry went national and global. He often appears at Catholic youth conferences around the country and is a six-time World Youth Day attendee and three-time performer at this amazing event. As a recording artist, he has produced four full-length CDs, and is often Referred to as the Roamin' Catholic Guy!

His desire to grow in faith and dive deeper into ministry resulted in a Masters of Theological Studies degree from the Franciscan School of Theology. His special study was Media & Spirituality. So great was his passion for the charisms of St. Francis, he later worked for the school as its Director of Recruitment and Admissions.

Fortunately, in the midst of a busy life of ministry, Vince got married and has four children (Veronica, Toby, Joshua and Stella). His wife, Keri, also works for a Catholic parish in the area of Faith Formation.

Vince loves young people and parish ministry. He has a joyful, playful spirit and disposition that makes everyone feel comfortable. He's a Giant's fan, loves tri-tip and really enjoys movies and popcorn—with lots of butter!
