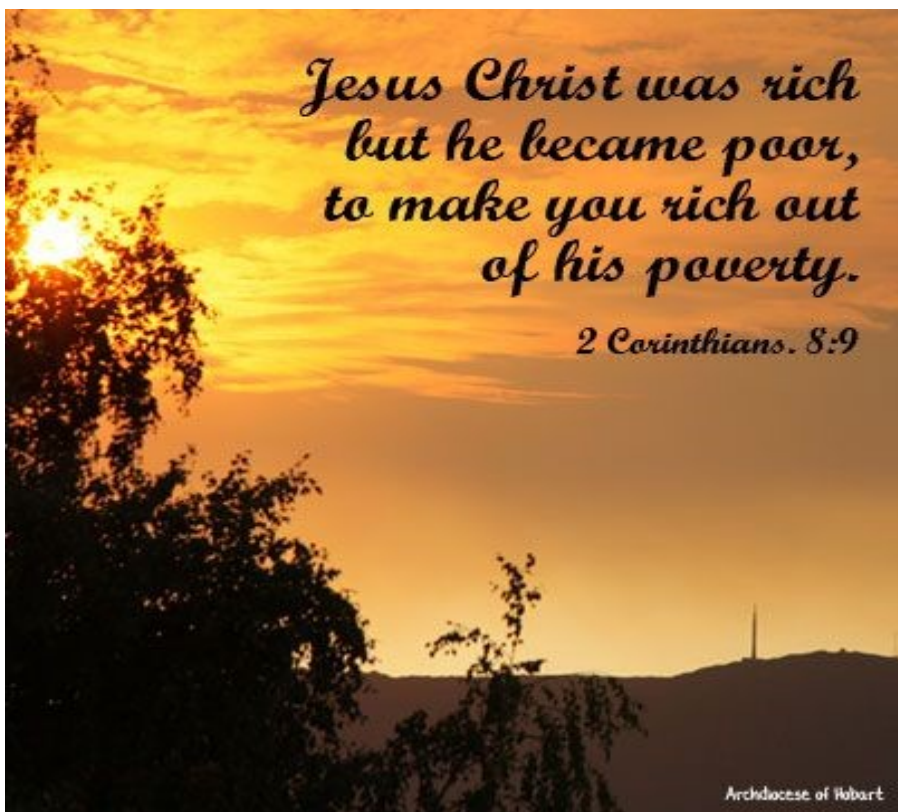

**PASTOR'S NOTE: TOWN HALL WITH ARCHBISHOP CORDILEONE**

Dear Parishioners,

On Sunday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 5 pm, St. Anthony is hosting Archbishop Cordileone at a town hall meeting on the sexual abuse scandal.

Our Parish Leadership Council sent the Archbishop a list of questions and concerns developed from the concerns expressed by our parishioners at our town hall meeting on September 6<sup>th</sup>, as well as a proposed format for the town hall meeting.

We also invited the pastors from other Marin parishes to solicit questions from their parishioners and to submit those questions to us by end of Thursday, September 27<sup>th</sup>; we will compile and submit all questions to the Archbishop on Friday, September 28<sup>th</sup>.

St Anthony's questions:

1. The perception is that the bishops are not taking action to eliminate priestly abuse. What are the U.S. bishops actively doing to locate and remove abusers?
2. How do you answer the perception that the latest revelation of abuses in Pennsylvania is not a result of a do-nothing hierarchy?
3. What is being done in the seminaries to screen out men who could be abusers from being ordained? Specifically, what is being done at St Patrick's Seminary to screen out potential sexual predators?
4. Since you have been archbishop, how much archdiocesan money has been spent to settle abuse cases/claims? In that connection, how much archdiocesan money has been spent on legal fees to defend such cases/claims?
5. Does the archdiocese have an investigative unit for cases of alleged priestly abuse? Who are the laypersons in that unit?

6. When a priest is accused, what is the archdiocesan procedure to conduct an investigation? Are the police informed immediately?
7. Are diocesan priests instructed to report suspected incidents of abuse by their fellow priests?
8. Does the Vatican have an overarching plan to discover and remove priests who commit abuse?
9. Is there a protocol among the USCCB for disciplining bishops who have shuttled priests from parish to parish?
10. Does the Vatican have a protocol for disciplining bishops who have shuttled abusive priests from parish to parish?

The Archbishop requested the following: that the town hall be held in the hall instead of the church, that we begin with Evening Prayers, and that Fr. Andrew Spyrow be the moderator of the town hall meeting.

The Archbishop accepted the rest of the format for the town hall meeting as proposed by our Parish Leadership Council. After Evening Prayers, we have requested the Archbishop to address the questions that were previously submitted to him by all Marin pastors in an opening statement.

At the conclusion of the Archbishop's opening remarks, each parish in Marin County will designate one representative to ask the Archbishop one question. Given the number of parishes in Marin County, that may be all the evening will allow. To maintain an orderly procedure, the moderator will call each parish one at a time to present its question to the Archbishop.

If there is remaining time after the parish questions are exhausted, we suggest that individuals be randomly selected to ask the Archbishop a question. The moderator will impose a 90 second time limit on all questions.

Seating is limited in the parish hall, so seating will be on a first come, first served basis.

The Archbishop has allotted 90 minutes for the town hall meeting, excluding the Evening Prayers. We assume that when the time limit is reached, the Archbishop will lead a closing prayer.

Given that we were given one week to organize the town hall meeting with the Archbishop, we apologize that we were not able to consult with you, our parishioners, regarding the format of the town hall meeting.

I ask you to join me in praying for our Archbishop and for the success of this town hall meeting.

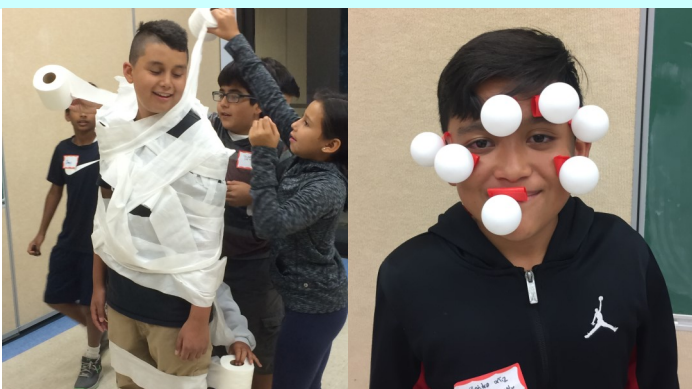
