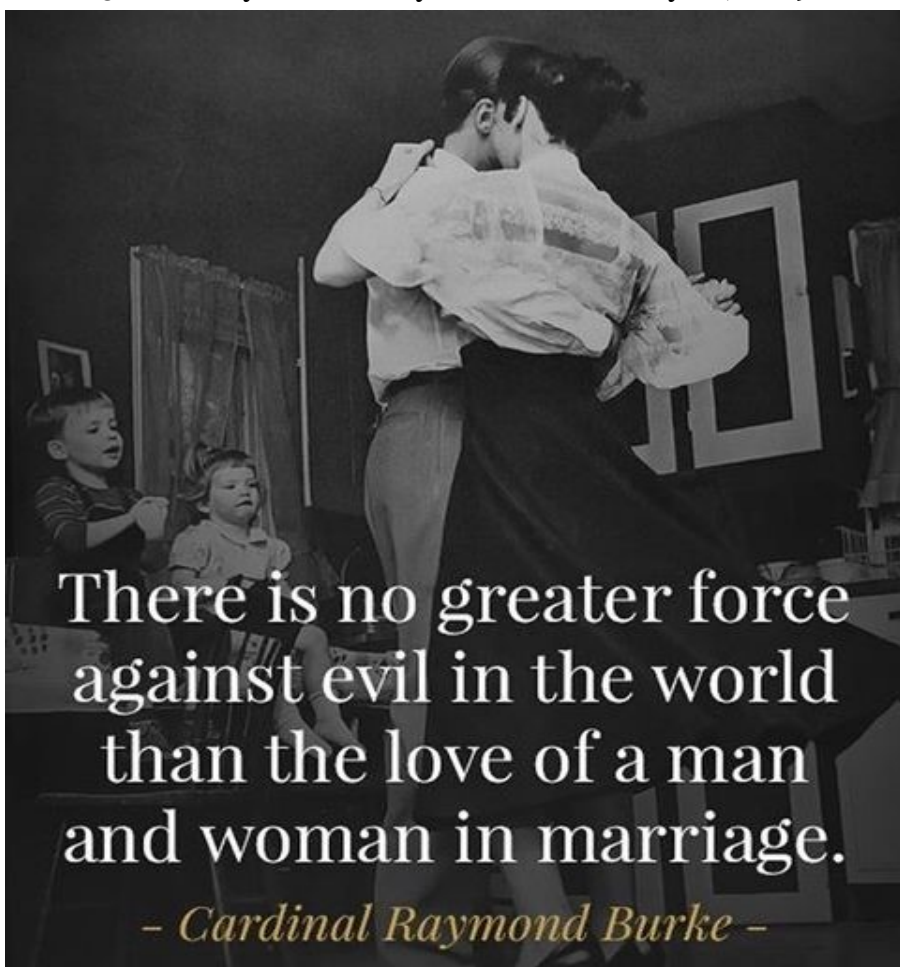

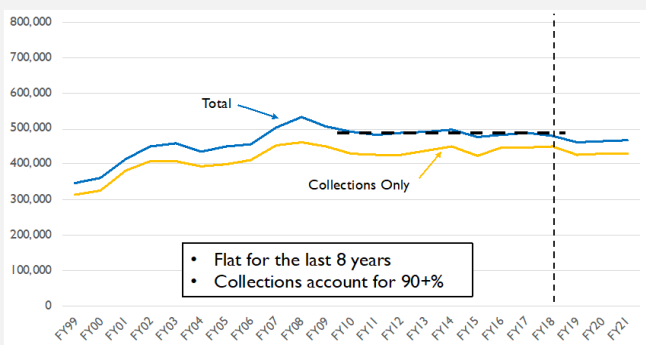
STEVE GIFFONI'S PRESENTATION FROM JANUARY 24TH PARISH FAMILY MEETING "SHOULD ST. ANTHONY'S BE MERGED?"

This week, we will print part 1 (of 2) of Steve's Giffoni's presentation on the financial outlook of the parish.

Major points:

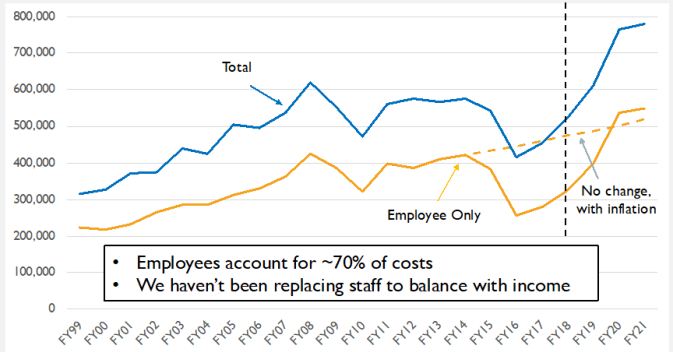
1. Operating Income has been flat for 8+ years
2. We need to increase our staffing levels, which will impact our expenses
3. Leading to a significant ongoing structural deficit
4. Without a change, we will burn through our unrestricted savings in 4-5 years

OPERATING INCOME



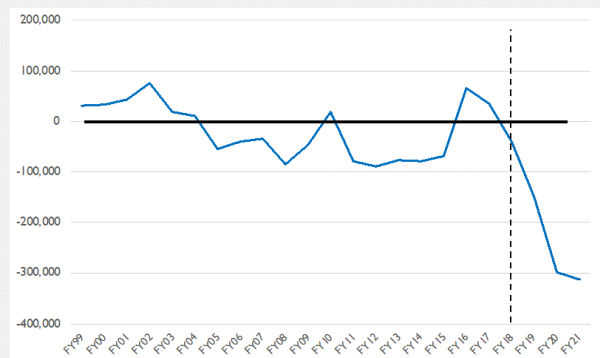
Operating income was growing until 2008. Quick decline and then relatively flat for the last 8 years. For budget purposes, we did assume a 5% reduction in collections for FY19 due to priest abuse crisis. Sunday collections account for 90%+ of total operating income. The Archdiocese expects a balanced budget each year.

OPERATING EXPENSES



The only way to balance the budget with flat income is to hold/reduce costs. We've used attrition in personnel in order to stay balanced since employee cost is the single largest item (70%) we have to control. We went from clergy/staff of 13+ in 2003 to 8 today. This has led to an increased load on the pastor, all staff, and volunteers. The Leadership Council made a strategic move this last fiscal year to increase music program funding and hire a full-time youth minister. We believe strongly that another full-time staff Parish Administrator is needed to help manage the overall parish operations and bring us back to where we were just 5 years ago.

NET OPERATING INCOME - STRUCTURAL DEFICIT



As you can see, we have actually been operating at a loss for most of the last 15 years and if we move forward with our staffing plans, the deficit is pretty significant. Note that the positive FY16 and FY17 net income is primarily related to reduced staffing and not from higher collections. The gap is made up from non-operating income.

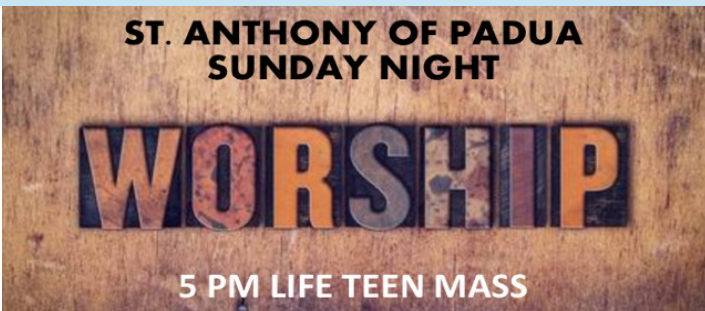


LIFE TEEN Life Teen Meal and Gathering:
