JOHN POCOCNY'S UPDATE ON MAINTENANCE PROJECTS FOR ST. ANTHONY'S

1. Hall and Church Bathroom project. Currently we are working with contractors to get bids for this project. The project consists of upgrading the Hall and Church bathrooms and adding an approved handicap bathroom in the hall. Architect plans have been approved by the city of Novato and contractor bids are due into the Archdiocese office the first week of March.
2. Parking lot fencing damage in the recent storm has been ordered and should be installed within the next couple of weeks. Please note that this is custom fencing and needed to be special ordered.
3. Parking lot light damaged in the storm also has been ordered. No date for installation. This is also a custom product.
4. Replacement Flag pole damaged in the storm has been ordered.
5. Repair of parking lot where tree fell over has been discussed with the parish Gardener and he will remove broken asphalt, flatten out area and put in a couple of plants.
6. During the most recent storm the flat roof over the church men's bathroom started to leak. We are in the process of getting bids for repair. Please note that we may also have an issue with the women's bathroom room. We will investigate.

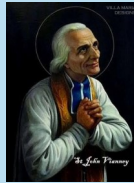
