Pastor's Note: "You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek."

Today (May 19) marks the 7th anniversary of my ordination as a priest. I can remember my ordination day as clear as a bell! It was a beautiful day in San Francisco and I was joined by my family from Singapore. I was somewhat nervous but mostly excited about what was going to happen that day when Archbishop Niederauer would lay his hands on my head and anoint my hands with chrism.

Although I could never have dreamed or anticipated then what these 7 years have brought, I am grateful for every one of them: for three years at St. Cecilia Parish in San Francisco, and for four years in my first pastorate here at St. Anthony.

The life of the Catholic Church over those years has included great joy and tragic sadness. For the former we offer God our praise and thanksgiving, for the latter we ask the Lord for his mercy and healing ... Still, in every one of those years I have counted myself blessed to serve God's people as a priest and blessed by the people it's been my privilege to serve. I thank God for all of you!
