This past month we have had to say good-bye to Mz. Liz, our Faith Formation Coordinator, who has been with the St. Anthony of Padua family for more than 8 years.

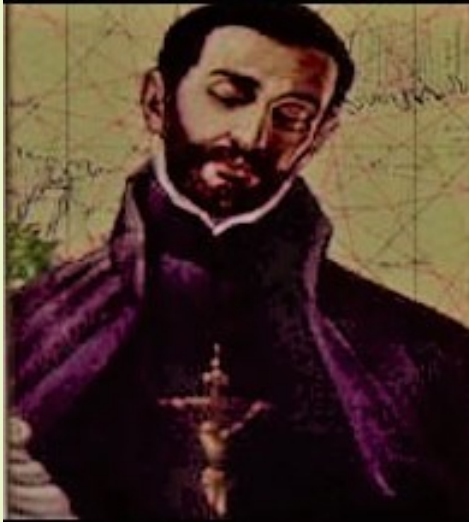

SAINT OF THE WEEK**St. Peter Claver
Feast Day**

St. Peter Claver was born at Verdu, Cataonia, Spain, in 1580, of impoverished parents descended from ancient and distinguished families. He studied at the Jesuit college

of Barcelona, entered the Jesuit novitiate at Tarragona in 1602 and took his final vows on August 8th, 1604.

In 1610, he landed at Cartagena (modern Colombia), the principal slave market of the New World, where a thousand slaves landed every month. After his ordination in 1616, he dedicated himself by special vow to the service of the African slaves—a work that was to last for thirty-three years.

He labored unceasingly for the salvation of the African slaves and the abolition of the slavery. St. Peter Claver spent the rest of his life teaching, praying with and taking care of the slaves and sick people in Colombia. It is in St. Peter's example that the words of Matthew 25:40, "As you did it to one of the least of these, you did it to me." It is in the service to those in need that we serve Jesus and the church.

St. Peter is a constant reminder that no life is too small, no person is without worth and dignity, that all people are worth the love of the Lord. Let us be reminded as a church community that even today all people are worth the love of the Lord. We must ask ourselves, do I love everyone I come in contact with? Do I leave people better than I found them? Do I try not to judge? Am I a reflection of the Lord's love to all his children, not just the ones I agree with? This week let us try to love everyone we come in contact with.
